





VNA Health Care is a humanitarian, not-for-profit organization that provides comprehensive primary care, home-based services, and a wide range of other medical, health, and community wellness programs for people living in suburban Chicago and beyond. VNA strives to improve the standard of health for all with high-quality, accessible, and compassionate care delivered in VNA health centers, community settings, and patient homes.



As the close of 2025 approaches, there is much to be thankful for and much for which we must prepare. We exceeded our goals in many areas this past year while adjusting to and planning for more substantial changes in health policy and reimbursement. As in other times of rapid change during more than a century of service – and much like an oak tree – VNA Health Care draws strength from its roots while maintaining flexibility.

As part of VNA's "root system," I am happy to share with you that we continue to make excellent progress in expanding access to care across suburban Chicago. Over the past several years, we have raised nearly \$5 million for our Growing for Tomorrow campaign and have added more clinics – in Joliet, Villa Park, and a third large clinic in Aurora at the former Copley Hospital, as well as a School-Linked Health Center serving students in the West Aurora School District. On the horizon is the expansion of our clinic off Farnsworth Avenue in Aurora and the build-out of shell space at our clinic on Villa Street in Elgin.

Importantly, as we continue to increase the number of patients served year over year, we maintain our commitment to excellence. This year, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) recognized VNA as being among the top 20% of Community Health Centers (CHCs) nationwide for overall quality of care. HRSA also acknowledged VNA as a National Quality Leader in Heart Health and Diabetes Health, and awarded VNA badges for Preventive Health Outcomes, Advancing Health Information Technology for Quality, Improving Access to Care, and High Value Care. VNA's cost per patient remains significantly lower than the state and national CHC averages, enabling us to maximize scarce resources. All in all, we are fulfilling our mission by providing outstanding, high-quality health care to a large and growing number of people, regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay.

While considerable challenges lie ahead, we feel your support and are deeply grateful for it. In the months to come, we will tap into our collective wisdom and abilities to thoughtfully adapt. As we move forward, we reaffirm our commitment to keeping our patients' well-being at the very center of our decisions – just as this organization has done for more than 100 years!



#### **Patient Ethnicity**







# Advancing Access Through Expansion and Innovation

In 2025, VNA strengthened its commitment to accessible and quality care for all, opening new health centers and expanding its overall footprint and service offerings.

#### **New Clinic & Immediate Care in Aurora**

In April, VNA completed the build out of 26,000 square feet and officially opened its newest location and fifth Health Center in Aurora. This VNA location, at 323 Weston Avenue on Aurora's east side, is within the former Copley Hospital campus now named Bloomhaven.

In addition to offering comprehensive primary care services, including family practice, obstetrics/gynecology, and pediatrics, as well as mental & behavioral health, physical therapy, podiatry, pharmacy, lab, and vaccination services, VNA began offering Immediate Care services for the first time. While individuals can continue to access medical services at any VNA clinic without an appointment, at the Immediate Care center, patients can access expanded services including x-rays, sutures, soft casting, minor burn treatment, and more. These services at VNA serve as an affordable and convenient option for patients, helping them avoid costly Emergency Department visits. VNA's Weston Avenue Health Center is open 7 days a week.

Support for this Health Center includes New Markets Tax Credit financing through JPMorgan Chase and the IFF, a \$500,000 grant from the City of Aurora, and additional financing through BMO Bank.







# Scaling Up the VNA Pharmacy

This October, VNA expanded its on-site pharmacy services with its newest location at Weston Avenue in Aurora. VNA now operates 4 pharmacy locations, a growth of 3 new pharmacies in just the past 3 years. VNA's on-site pharmacies make it easy for patients to fill prescriptions, access discounted 340B program medications, and receive guidance from VNA pharmacists who communicate directly with their VNA care team. VNA patients can also receive 340B discounts at local participating CVS, Walmart, and Walgreens pharmacies.



## **Bringing Quality Care to Villa Park**

VNA expanded its footprint in March with the opening of a new 6,000-square-foot Health Center in Villa Park. This new location is situated on a busy thoroughfare in the heart of the community with easy access to public transportation.

This Health Center features 12 exam rooms, an on-site lab, and a wellness classroom and kitchen for health education and nutrition programs. VNA's Villa Park clinic offers primary care services for all ages, including family practice, women's health, and pediatrics.



# More Patients and More Services



#### **More Moms & Babies**

High quality and accessible Obstetrics (OB) and Pediatric care is vital to the health of the women and infants in our communities. While some health care organizations in our area are no longer providing OB services, VNA is committed to providing it and now offers OB services at 7 of its locations.

VNA provides prenatal health care for thousands of underserved women and offers hundreds of prenatal and parenting classes to expecting parents. And over 1,700 infants were delivered by VNA obstetricians and midwives at local hospitals.

#### **More Students**

Through its school-based health center at East Aurora High School and its school-linked health centers with West Aurora School District 129 and Romeoville High School, VNA provided care to over 1,500 students.



These centers enable students to access quality, affordable primary care, mental/behavioral health, and nutrition counseling during the school day and over the summer.

VNA also increased its collaboration with area schools and now works closely with 18 school districts to connect their students and families to much needed health care services.

#### **More Older Adults**

VNA continues to expand its ability to serve older adults.
This year, work in Aurora included home care for residents of Aurora Housing Authority's new 1449 Senior Estates and a designated clinic at VNA's new Weston Avenue location for Bloomhaven residents.



In Joliet, VNA expanded its relationship with the Joliet Housing Authority to provide home-based care to seniors residing at the new Stevenson Crossing community.

Overall, VNA provided nearly 3,000 home-based visits, bringing essential health care to those better served within their homes.

#### **More Digital**



This year, VNA expanded its digital reach, making it easier than ever for patients to engage with VNA and their health information.

VNA welcomed more patients to MyChart and increased online appointment scheduling for both existing and new patients. Text message campaigns allowed VNA to share timely updates and reminders. Growth in its social media community allowed VNA to better connect with patients where they already are online. And VNA is exploring appropriate and safe ways to leverage more telehealth and AI for increased access and efficiencies!



## Driving Clinical Quality

At VNA Health Care, quality is at the heart of its mission, reflecting an ongoing commitment to delivering excellent, patient-centered care. The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) recognized VNA as being in the top 20% of Community Health Centers nationwide for overall quality. HRSA recognized VNA in six additional areas as well.

For **Diabetes** and **Heart Health**, VNA met or exceeded national benchmarks for management of these pervasive chronic diseases, which affect many of its patients.






# Tackling Diabetes and Heart Health

With 10% of VNA patients having a diagnosis of diabetes and 15% of patients at increased risk of cardiovascular events, VNA focuses much attention on the management of chronic health conditions. VNA's Diabetes Total Care program, nutrition programs, and pharmacy services contribute to positive patient outcomes.

# VNA Helps Patient Control Diabetes & Regain Mobility

An older adult patient, who had been struggling with out-of-control glucose levels and difficulty walking, was referred to VNA's Diabetes Total Care program. Her VNA provider adjusted her diabetic medications, educated her on the importance of taking her medications, and referred her to physical therapy at VNA for mobility concerns. The patient's diabetes is now under control, she no longer needs a walker, and her family is more involved in her care.





# Improving the Patient Experience



#### **Increasing Patient Feedback**

Patient feedback yields deeper insights into patient needs, preferences, and concerns – helping VNA identify strengths, address areas for improvement, and enhance the overall patient experience. This valuable feedback loop supports continuous improvement and reinforces trust within the VNA community.

#### VNA's Mobile Clinic Supports New Foster Family

Through its Mobile Clinic program, VNA partners with local agencies and school districts to host multiple back-to-school physical events across the community. At one event, a child was seen who had recently moved into a new foster home without his necessary medications for food allergies and asthma. The VNA provider completed his school physical and vaccinations, prescribed an epi-pen and inhaler, and educated his foster parent on their proper use. This encounter reflects VNA's commitment to ensuring every child has access to the care, medications, and support they need to stay healthy and ready for school.

## **Growing for Tomorrow Campaign**

As VNA's Growing for Tomorrow campaign comes to a close in 2026, we are excited to share that we are nearing our \$5 million goal. These funds are helping build new facilities, enlarge or improve current facilities, and provide operational support for expanded services. We are truly grateful for the generous support of our donors and grantors—past, present, and future—which allows VNA to pursue ambitious plans to serve even more patients across suburban Chicago. #### This year, VNA has:

- Opened a new 26,000-square-foot VNA Health Center at 323 Weston Avenue in Aurora offering primary care, immediate care, mental/behavioral health services, and a pharmacy
- Opened a new VNA Health Center in Villa Park, further expanding access to care in that area
- Started the expansion of the VNA Health Center in Bolingbrook
- Provided care to nearly 86,000 patients of all ages

# Expanded Services in Action

Immediate Care at the new Weston Avenue clinic is helping patients get the treatment they need while reducing unnecessary hospital visits. Recently, an uninsured patient with a foot injury received a same-day X-ray at the clinic. The exam showed a sprain rather than a fracture, allowing

the patient to get prompt care without the need for an avoidable Emergency Department visit.






#### Sources of Revenue FY25


